POP3: Best option if accessing email on one device only, or one device and webmail. Your email program (Outlook, Thunderbird, etc) connects to our server, grabs new email to be stored on your device, then deletes it from our server, either immediately or after the time period you indicate in your email setup. **Do not leave mail on server indefinitely or you will max out your server space quota.**

Incoming server (POP3): mailhost.constantdatacenter.com

Port: 995 or 110

Encrypted connection (SSL): Yes

Outgoing server (SMTP): mailhost.constantdatacenter.com

Port: 465, 25 or 587

Encryption type: TLS

Do not permanently leave a copy on server.

Outgoing server requires authentication using same settings (login/password) as incoming server.

IMAP: To be used to synchronize all email activity (inbox, sent, and other folders) across multiple devices. All email is stored on our server and copies are displayed in your devices' email programs. When deleted from a device, it deletes it from our server, but otherwise leaves everything on our server. *All devices used to synchronize email (desktop, phone, laptop, tablet) must be set up as IMAP for this to work properly.* **With IMAP, it is important to keep inbox, sentbox, trash and spam cleaned out or you will max out your server space quota.**

Incoming server (IMAP): mailhost.constantdatacenter.com

Port: 993 or 143

Encryption type: TLS

Outgoing server (SMTP): mailhost.constantdatacenter.com

Port: 465, 25 or 587

Encryption type: TLS

Browser webmail email access: If using POP3, new email accessed here will remain on the server until deleted using a POP3 mail client (Outlook, thunderbird, etc). Email sent through webmail will only be accessible in webmail. If using IMAP, anything you do in webmail will synchronize with all other IMAP devices.
